- 550 acres, including over 400 water acres
- Continuous waterfront esplanade
- 13 Public Park/Recreation Piers
- Limited “park compatible” commercial development
- Self-sustaining financial operations

Hudson River Park Trust

1. Creation of Hudson River Park Trust to design, build, operate and maintain the park.
2. A joint partnership of the City and State with equal power.
3. Land use restrictions govern every pier & protect against excessive commercial development.
4. The water out to the pierhead line is designated as a marine sanctuary.
5. The Trust must fund operations and maintenance exclusively through revenues produces by the park's commercial uses.
